There cannot be a more urgent priority for Europe than to educate its young people to be peaceful. The marked change in populations of young people alongside the pervasive influence of technological development and the competing forces of localism and globalisation have given rise to the need to enhance social cohesion, and to learn civic values and mutual understanding.

The UPPER project (Systemic UPscaling of Peace Education pRactices) aims at bringing peace, inter-cultural dialogue and civic participation at the heart of educative policies and school practices by reinforcing the results of good practices already identified in existing programs. UPPER has now elaborated a Good Practice Report, a Teacher's competence Framework, an Handbook for Peace Education, and a collaborative benchmarking system for actors in the field of Education.

In order to perpetuate the activities of the UPPER project, partners have seized the opportunity to establish an "Education inspiring Peace Laboratory" or "EIP Lab" in Sanremo.
